

71st JUNIOR BOYS' AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP



Vandal Golf Course, Moscow, Idaho | August 10-14, 2026

Field Limit: 96 | Entry Fee: \$220 | Deadline for Entry: July 20, 2026 at 12:00 p.m.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to male amateur golfers who: (1) will not have reached their nineteenth birthday by midnight of August 14, 2026, (2) have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index or Golf Canada Handicap Factor not exceeding 8.4, and (3) are members in good standing of a PPGA Member Association (AGA, BC Golf, IGA, MSGA, OGA, WA Golf) or have received a Presidential Invitation.

Age: Player's date of birth is required on all PPGA entry forms. An application for a player who is a minor upon the date of submission, must be submitted by a parent/guardian, and list parent/guardian's name, phone number, and email address. The parent/guardian must agree to be bound by all terms and conditions on their behalf and on behalf of the minor player.

FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to the first 96 qualified entrants. At the close of entry, the field of 96 will be filled by the lowest USGA Handicap Indexes and Golf Canada Handicap Factors in addition to exempt players and Presidential Invitees.

This championship runs concurrently with the PPGA Junior Girls' Amateur, which has a field limit of 48. The PPGA reserves the right to modify either field limit to achieve a full field of 144 players.

ENTRIES: FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE

All players, including those who are exempt, must have an entry application submitted either by: (1) at the PPGA website (thepnga.org) with a credit card, or (2) by mail with a completed paper application form and check or credit card authorization form.

Entry fee of \$220 (USD) must be paid by every player. Payment will be processed at the time of entry. A full refund will be issued to players who are placed on a waiting list and do not make the starting field.

Entry applications, along with the appropriate fee, must be completed or received by the PPGA by 12:00 p.m. on Monday, July 20, 2026.

Late entry applications may be accepted and used to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the PPGA staff establishes. Late entry applications will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the PPGA in order to submit a late entry application.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds due to cancellation before the close of entry are subject to a \$10 service charge. After the close of entry and up until round one pairings are released, players who withdraw for any reason will be refunded 50% of the entry fee. No refund for any reason will be issued after round one pairings have been released.

CONDITIONS

The PPGA reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, on any matter, shall be final.

DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing while on host club property. The PPGA Dress Code Policy is available at the following link: thepnga.org/policies and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, in the Player Memorandum.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The PPGA may reject an entry application, revoke an accepted application, expel from the championship and/or suspend a player from future championships if the player engages in conduct detrimental to the integrity and image of the game of golf and/or public confidence in the PPGA. The PPGA Code of Conduct Policy is available at the following link: thepnga.org/policies and will be provided to all players in the Player Memorandum.

CADDIES

A player may provide his own caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

EXCEPTION: A player's caddie must not have reached their nineteenth birthday on the day in which they caddie.

CARTS

The Local Rule prohibiting the use of motorized transportation as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.

As a general rule, players and their caddies must walk the course at PPGA Championships. But consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), a disabled player or caddie may be permitted to use a golf cart as an accommodation to his or her disability. As required by the ADA, the PPGA will evaluate such requests on a case-by-case basis. The

PRACTICE ROUND

All players will be allowed one complimentary practice round prior to the championship. Players may not schedule their complimentary practice round under after entries have closed and the field is set.

SCHEDULE

(A) STROKE PLAY: 36-hole stroke play to determine 32 qualifiers for match play. A tie for the last qualifier's place will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off.

(B) MATCH PLAY: A draw based on qualifying scores will be used. Ties in qualifying rounds will be decided by a blind draw, except that places of those participating in a play-off will be determined by performance in the play-off.

UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL

During play of the championship, a competitor who withdraws must notify PPGA staff and fill out a withdraw form. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not notifying PPGA or without having sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future PPGA Championship for a minimum of two years.

ONSITE CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

Register in person at location and time listed in the Player Memorandum. Players must register prior to starting round one play.
