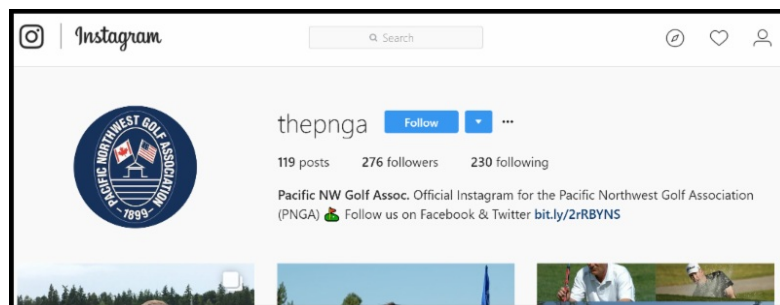

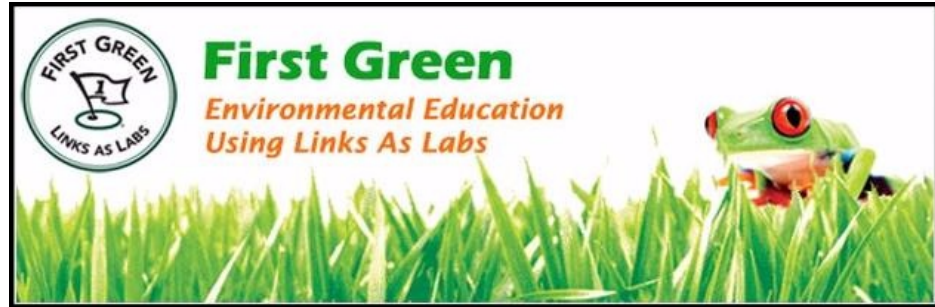
Our championship staff does an incredible job of putting on the best amateur events in the Pacific Northwest, but they could not accomplish this without your help!
