**REGISTRATION**

All contestants must register with the PNGA, at Seattle Golf Club, outside the golf shop, prior to playing in the PNGA Cup (register before your practice round). The following registration hours have been scheduled:

**WEDNESDAY, MAY 2: 11:00 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.**

**SCHEDULE**

**WEDNESDAY, MAY 2: (12:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m.) Practice Rounds**

**THURSDAY, MAY 3 (8:00 a.m. – 8:50 a.m. #1 and #10 tees): Four-Ball Matches**

One side plays their better ball against the better ball of the other side.

**THURSDAY, MAY 3 (1:30 p.m. – 2:20 p.m. #1 and #10 tees): Foursome Matches**

Players play alternately from the teeing grounds and alternately during play of each hole.

**FRIDAY, MAY 4 (8:00 a.m. – 8:50 a.m. #1 and #10 tees): Singles Matches**

Players will compete in singles matches.

**PLAYOFF**

If there is a tie between teams after scheduled play, a playoff format is in place which will break the tie based on the head to head record of the teams involved.

**CELL PHONE POLICY**

Seattle Golf Club Cell Phone Policy - Use of personal electronic devices (smart phones) is prohibited on the golf course or in the clubhouse. If you need to make a call or send an email or text, please do it in your car or in one of the phone booths located in the locker rooms.

**PRACTICE ROUND**

Each contestant may play one complimentary practice round at Seattle Golf Club prior to the championship. Practice rounds will be available on Wednesday, May 2 from 12:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m. Players must schedule a practice round during the online registration process.

## **DRESS CODE**

### **TEAM ATTIRE**

Players will be encouraged to wear matching team uniforms (i.e., shirts, outerwear, etc.) with their respective association logo, provided by their own association.

### **MEN**

The PNGA expects all contestants and their caddies to wear suitable attire on the host club property throughout the duration of the championship, including practice rounds. Suitable attire does not include cutoffs, short shorts, tank tops, jeans or denim of any kind or color, tee shirts, sweat pants or unkempt clothing of any kind. Contestants must wear neat and clean slacks, Bermuda, or walking shorts. Shorts must be of an appropriate length and must meet the host club dress code policy. Golf shirts with collars or golf mocks are mandatory. Hats and visors must not be worn in the clubhouse. Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. Sandals of any kind, even sandals with soft spikes, are not allowed on the golf course at any time, including practice areas. If additional measures are required by the host club, they will be communicated to all contestants prior to the championship and must be adhered to. Gallery must adhere to the host club dress code policy. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in disqualification and removal from the course.

### **WOMEN**

The PNGA expects all contestants and their caddies to wear suitable attire on the host club property throughout the duration of the championship, including practice rounds. Suitable attire does not include cutoffs, short shorts, tank tops, halters, jeans or denim of any kind or color, tee shirts, bare midriff, spandex, sweat pants or unkempt clothing of any kind. Contestants must wear blouses or golf shirts (if a shirt is sleeveless, it must have a collar). Contestants must wear slacks, golf skirts or shorts. Skirts and shorts must be of an appropriate length and must meet the host club dress code policy. Hats and visors must not be worn in the clubhouse. Shoes and socks must be worn at all times. Sandals of any kind, even sandals with soft spikes, are not allowed on the golf course at any time, including practice areas. If additional measures are required by the host club, they will be communicated to all contestants prior to the championship and must be adhered to. Gallery must adhere to the host club dress code policy. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in disqualification and removal from the course.

## **GOLF SHOP**

The golf shop will open each day from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

## **CADDIES**

A limited number of host club caddies may be available with prior notice. Please contact Doug Doxsie, PGA in the golf shop to make arrangements.

## **AUTOMOTIVE CARTS**

The use of automotive carts during play will be permitted. Cart fees must be paid to the golf shop at the time of rental and are \$15 per player.

## **PULL CARTS**

Pull carts are permitted. Players should provide their own cart.

### **RANGE BALLS**

Range balls will be available at the driving range during the practice round and on each day of the championship, courtesy of the PNGA. The range will open each day from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

### **CLUB STORAGE**

Club storage will be available to players beginning on Wednesday, May 2. Arrangements can be made in the golf shop.

### **LOCKER ROOM**

The men's and women's locker rooms will be available. Lockers will not be available. Hanging racks will be put in the Library for use by players from Wednesday – Friday.

### **CONTESTANT LUNCHESES**

A buffet lunch, hosted by the PNGA, will take place in the clubhouse upstairs dining room on Thursday, May 3 from 12:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. and on Friday, May 4 from 12:30 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. If a player plans to have a guest for lunch (spouse, caddie, etc.) on either day, they must register and pay the associated fee online prior to April 20. Guest lunches are \$25 (USD) per day.

### **CONTESTANT BANQUET**

The banquet, hosted by the PNGA, will take place on Thursday, May 3 in the upstairs dining room. No-host cocktails will begin at 6:30 p.m. with dinner following at 7:30 p.m. The banquet is a formal affair; appropriate banquet or dinner attire **is required**. This may include dresses, skirts, pants, blouses, sweaters, blazers, etc. for women and coat and ties for men. Each player may bring one guest. Players must register their guests online and pay the associated fee prior to April 20. The guest banquet fee is \$50 (USD). **Contestants are required to attend the banquet.**

### **FOOD SERVICE (NO-HOST)**

On Wednesday food service will be available in the clubhouse before practice rounds from 11:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Bar service only will be available following practice rounds.

On Thursday and Friday, breakfast sandwiches (\$7), pastries (\$3), and a coffee station will be available outside the golf shop from 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.

### **PAYMENT METHODS**

Cash and all major credit cards are accepted in the golf shop. In the clubhouse and for all food and beverage service, players may either charge back to a reciprocal club or they must charge under their name to the PNGA master account. All charges to the master account will be sorted out after the event and players will be billed directly by the PNGA.

### **AWARDS CEREMONY**

The awards presentation ceremony will be held in the clubhouse on Friday, May 5 and will begin immediately after all matches have been completed (approximately 2:00 p.m.).

**Contestants are required to attend the awards ceremony to its entirety.**

## **PRIZES**

The traveling crystal perpetual PNGA Cup trophy will be held at the winning association's headquarters for the ensuing year. Each member of the winning team will receive a Kusak crystal trophy. The winning associations name will be inscribed on the silver perpetual "PNGA Cup" that is housed at the PNGA offices.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

The PNGA expects all contestants, caddies, gallery, and guests to exhibit proper conduct and behavior on the golf course and anywhere on club property during a PNGA championship. Unbecoming conduct or behavior may be grounds for immediate disqualification, at any time, from any PNGA event. The following are some examples of unbecoming conduct or behavior:

- Loud, abusive and/or profane language
- Intentionally throwing and/or breaking equipment or the like (club, ball, etc.) in anger or frustration
- Intentionally damaging host club, PNGA, and/or fellow contestant property
- Abuse of any kind of host club officials, volunteers or staff; and/or PNGA volunteers, staff or fellow contestants
- Public criticism of host club, officials, volunteers or staff; and/or PNGA volunteers, staff or fellow contestants
- Intentionally engaging in a criminal act
- Engaging in activities that result in the potential endangerment of others
- Intentionally violating the Rules of Golf
- Intentionally violating stated club policy
- Violation of PNGA Dress Code
- Violation of PNGA Footwear Policy

The Committee in charge of the competition shall be the sole judge of determining Conduct Code violations.

## **LODGING**

Contestants are encouraged to make lodging arrangements at the earliest possible date. The PNGA has arranged for reserved rooms at the host hotel. Standard rates at this hotel is much higher at this time. To obtain the group rate, contestants must make reservations online with the link provided.
