36th MEN'S MID-AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

Field Limit: 90 | Entry Fee: \$200 | Deadline for Entry: August 31, 2020 at 4:30 p.m.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to male amateur golfers who: (1) will have reached their twenty-fifth birthday by September 16, 2020 (2) have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index or Golf Canada Handicap Factor not exceeding 8.4, and (2) are members in good standing of a PNGA member club.

Age: Player's date of birth is required on all entry forms.

FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to the first 90 qualified entrants. Entries will be accepted according to the time of receipt of entry and entry fee in addition to exempt players.

ENTRIES: FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE

All players, including those who are exempt, must have an entry application submitted either by: (1) at the PNGA website (thepnga.org) with a credit card, or (2) by mail with a completed paper application form and check or credit card authorization form.

Entry fee of \$200 (USD) must be paid by every player. Payment will be processed at the time of entry. A full refund will be issued to players who are placed on a waiting list and do not make the starting field.

Entry applications, along with the appropriate fee, must be completed or received by the PNGA by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, August 31, 2020.

Late entry applications may be accepted and used to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the PNGA staff establishes. Late entry applications will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the PNGA in order to submit a late entry application.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds due to cancellation before the close of entry are subject to a \$10 service charge. After the close of entry and up until round one pairings are released, refunds for documented and approved medical reasons are subject to a \$25 service charge. No refund for any reason will be issued after round one pairings have been released.

CONDITIONS

The PNGA reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, on any matter, shall be final.

DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing while on host club property. The PNGA Dress Code Policy is available at the following link: thepnga.org/policies and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, in the Player Memorandum.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The PNGA may reject an entry application, revoke an accepted application, expel from the Championship and/or suspend a player from future championships if the player engages in conduct detrimental to the integrity and image of the game of golf and/or public confidence in the PNGA. The PNGA Code of Conduct Policy is available at the following link: thepnga.org/policies and will be provided to all players in the Player Memorandum.

CADDIES

A player may provide his own caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

CARTS

Players and caddies may ride in a golf cart. Cart fees are \$18 per seat/day. Fees will be collected during registration.

PRACTICE ROUND

All players will be allowed one complimentary practice round prior to the Championship.

Consideration will be made for out-of-town players with regard to reserved starting times the day prior to the Championship. Contestants can reserve practice round times directly through the golf shop. All practice round times are at the discretion of the host club.

SCHEDULE

Championship - 90 players eligible. 54-hole stroke play. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff.

UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL

After the entry deadline and during play of the Championship, players must notify the PNGA and state his need to withdraw. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not notifying the PNGA or without having sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future PNGA Championship for a minimum of two years.

ONSITE CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

Register in person at location and time listed in the Player Memorandum. Players must register prior to starting round one play.

LODGING
