21st WOMEN'S MID-AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP



Twin Lakes Golf & Country Club, Federal Way, Wash. | September 19-21, 2023
Field Limit: 36 | Entry Fee: \$300 | Deadline for Entry: August 29, 2023 at 4:30 p.m.

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to female amateur golfers who: (1) will have reached their twenty-fifth birthday by September 19, 2023, (2) have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index or Golf Canada Handicap Factor not exceeding 12.4, and (3) are members in good standing of a PPGA Member Association (BC Golf, IGA, OGA, WA Golf) or have received a Presidential Invitation.

Age: Player's date of birth is required on all entry forms.

FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to 36 qualified entrants. At the close of entry, the field of 36 will be filled by the lowest USGA Handicap Indexes and Golf Canada Handicap Factors in addition to exempt players and Presidential Invitees.

This championship runs concurrently with the PPGA Women's Senior and Super Senior Championship which has a field limit of 54 total. The PPGA reserves the right to modify either field limit to achieve a full field of 90 players.

ENTRIES: FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE

All players, including those who are exempt, must have an entry application submitted either by: (1) at the PPGA website (thepnga.org) with a credit card, or (2) by mail with a completed paper application form and check or credit card authorization form.

Entry fee of \$300 (USD) must be paid by every player. Payment will be processed at the time of entry. A full refund will be issued to players who are placed on a waiting list and do not make the starting field.

Entry applications, along with the appropriate fee, must be completed or received by the PPGA by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 29, 2023.

Late entry applications may be accepted and used to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the PPGA staff establishes. Late entry applications will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the PPGA in order to submit a late entry application.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds due to cancellation before the close of entry are subject to a \$10 service charge. After the close of entry and up until round one pairings are released, players who withdraw for any reason will be refunded 50% of the entry fee. No refund for any reason will be issued after round one pairings have been released.

CONDITIONS

The PPGA reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, on any matter, shall be final.

DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing while on host club property. The PPGA Dress Code Policy is available at the following link: thepnga.org/policies and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, in the Player Memorandum.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The PPGA may reject an entry application, revoke an accepted application, expel from the championship and/or suspend a player from future championships if the player engages in conduct detrimental to the integrity and image of the game of golf and/or public confidence in the PPGA. The PPGA Code of Conduct Policy is available at the following link: thepnga.org/policies and will be provided to all players in the Player Memorandum.

CADDIES

A player may provide her own caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

CARTS

Players and caddies may ride in a golf cart. Cart fees are \$25 per seat/day. Fees will be collected during registration.

PRACTICE ROUND

All players will be allowed one complimentary practice round prior to the Championship.

SCHEDULE

54-hole stroke play (gross only). In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff.

UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL

ADuring play of the championship, a competitor who withdraws must notify PPGA staff and fill out a withdraw form. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not notifying PPGA or without having sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future PPGA Championship for a minimum of two years.

ONSITE CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

Register in person at location and time listed in the Player Memorandum. Players must register prior to starting round one play.
